### **Memorandum of Interview**

Re: *USA v Angelo DiPietro*

A phone interview was conducted. Siriano stated that he represented **Frank Taddeo**. He stated that on Dec. 10, 2004, he was present when his client gave a proffer to the government. He stated that his client told the government that he never saw a gun displayed when he was questioned about a June 29, 2001 incident involving John Perazzo. He confirmed that he and his client signed releases to Anthony DiPietro allowing me to have his attorney work product notes. He stated that he met with Taddeo again on January 19, 2005, following the proffer meeting with the government. He said he discussed the case with his client and asked his client again about whether there was a gun. He stated that in this meeting Taddeo stated he never saw a gun. "His story never deviated," said Siriano.


