Memorandum of Interview

Date: Wednesday, November 11, 2009
At approximately 2:50 p.m. (central daylight time)

Person interviewed: Ded "David" Nicaj

Re: *USA v Angelo DiPietro*

Reporting agent made phone contact with Ded Nicaj. A message was left with his sister to contact me. I explained to Nicaj that I had been retained by the family of Angelo DiPietro to conduct a federal post conviction investigation. I explained that DiPietro is claiming actual innocence as to the Eastchester robbery for which he was convicted. I informed Nicaj that I would like to meet with him and that I planned to travel to New York next Friday.

I explained to Nicaj that DiPietro was convicted based on the testimony of Din Celaj. Nicaj stated he had never met Angelo DiPietro and DiPietro was not involved in any way with the Eastchester robbery. He stated that he would be willing to meet with me on Friday, November 20th. Reporting agent provided him with his cell phone. He stated that he would contact me Thursday evening for a place to meet. He suggested that he would be willing to meet in the city of New York. He was unwilling to provide his contact information.

I explained to Nicaj that I was contacted by Angelo's son, Anthony, who found my name through a search for investigators. I explained to him that I direct the innocence project in Illinois and Anthony contacted me because of my work with the innocence project. Nicaj indicated that he is familiar with the work of Barry Scheck at the innocence project and he stated that Angelo DiPietro is innocent of the allegation involving the Eastchester robbery.
